Travel

The most convenient airport to reach Karlsruhe is Frankfurt am Main, with many international connections. Trains to Karlsruhe (Karlsruhe Hbf) departure every hour directly from the train station in the airport "Frankfurt(M) Flughafen Fernbf (Long Distance Trains)". Timetables and online booking are available from Deutsche Bahn
